**CALL TO ORDER – INTRODUCTIONS**

- Setup ..... Ms. Simmons
- Teardown ..... Mr. Taylor

Members also discussed the order and initial bids of auctioned items (chucks, canvasses), pricing of other products (framed/unframed posters), selection criteria for People’s Choice chuck (highest sale amount), Mayor’s Choice (“Huck”), and how sale proceeds should be allocated.
