Tuesday, May 15, 2012

CALL TO ORDER/INTRODUCTIONS

Chair Hill called the meeting to order at 4:36 p.m. without a quorum present. Commissioner Cheshire arrived at 4:40 p.m., establishing a quorum. Commissioner Cook arrived at 4:48 p.m.

DISCUSSION/ACTION ITEMS

B. Action Item

Passport to the Arts Event

Chair Hill reviewed results of the subcommittee meeting on May 9, 2012, and "homework" assignments. This 1st annual RCAPP fund-raising event will be held on September 29, 2012. The proposed budget estimated Expenses at \$1,305 and Net Revenue at \$10,570.

RCAPP discussion covered *event scheduling, RCAPP booth, sales, e-marketing* (City website, Facebook), *ticket outlets, sponsorship, community partners* (Downtowners, service clubs, art outlets, restaurants, high school fund-raising groups), *artist booths, vendors* (shaved ice, beer, wine, food), *routes/street closures, related activities* (breakfast, art walk, children's art corner), *music, ribbon cutting, public safety* (crossing guards, barricades), *passport check-in process, photo opportunities, volunteer recruitment/management* (T-shirts), *color* (red), *supplies, artist release for student artists, and budget.*

Ms. Hale said the *Redmond Spokesman* is willing to help with fund-raising by publishing RCAPP announcements and information about student participation in City art projects.

Ms. Richards said that the City is working to engage youth in Public Works' projects and is considering Sam Johnson Park as a possible installation site for student art. She summarized key points of a banner program proposed by Commissioner Burton and said she would talk with Ethan Stelzer about appropriate art subjects for students.

Commissioner concerns included art subjects, media, color, and supervision of students.

A. Discussion

Roundabout Art

Ms. Richards said the City has been negotiating for an artist-in-residence to work with Redmond School District students on designing/producing art for the 27th Street Roundabout. Ryan Beard, a local artist, is very excited about the opportunity to participate. Concept details need to be worked out so this project can be included in the curriculum for the 2012-2013 school year.

RCAPP discussion covered *metal fabrication materials, equipment, and processes; expanding the student base* (Redmond Proficiency Academy, Central Oregon Community College); *potential contacts*; and *potential funding partners* (Kiwanis, Rotary, Redmond Executive Association).

COMMISSIONER COMMENTS

Chair Hill asked for a status report on using an empty downtown storefront to promote RCAPP. All commissioners expressed sorrow that Goody's was closing its Redmond store.

LIAISON COMMENTS

Ms. Richards reported that City Council has directed staff members to serve as liaisons to the various commissions. Councilors will review the draft minutes and participate in RCAPP meetings only when Commissioners or staff feel that a Council presence is needed.

CITIZEN COMMENTS (None)

STAFF COMMENTS

Ms. Richards said that the City has been reimbursed by insurance and is ready to install a replacement "Grace" in June 2012. Ethan Stelzer and Solomon Kaleialoha have applied to join RCAPP.
