REDMOND COMMITTEE FOR ART IN PUBLIC PLACES
MINUTES
June 18, 2019

CALL TO ORDER – INTRODUCTIONS

Chair Mooney called the regular meeting of the Redmond Committee for Art in Public Places (RCAPP) to order at 4:30 p.m., Tuesday, June 18, 2019, with a quorum present (6 of 9 members). Ms. Harris arrived at 5:07 p.m. after all motions, increasing the quorum to 7 of 9 members.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

A. April 16, 2019

Motion 1 (5/0/1): Ms. Hill moved to approve the April 16, 2019, meeting minutes as presented. Mr. Stelzer seconded the motion which passed with Ms. Hill, Mr. Mooney, Ms. Standerwick, Mr. Stelzer, and Mr. Taylor voting in favor, none opposed, and Ms. Burton abstaining due to her absence from the April meeting.

B. May 21, 2019

Ms. Burton requested correction of the May 21, 2019, minutes to replace “Denfeld Paints in Bend, Oregon,” with “Denfeld Paints in Redmond, Oregon” in Paragraph 2, Discussion/Action Item A (Tunnel Repainting Project Update).

Motion 2 (5/0/1): Ms. Burton moved to approve the May 21, 2019, meeting minutes as amended. Ms. Hill seconded the motion which passed with Ms. Burton, Ms. Hill, Mr. Mooney, Mr. Stelzer, and Mr. Taylor voting in favor, none opposed, and Ms. Standerwick abstaining due to her absence from the May meeting.

DISCUSSION/ACTION ITEMS

A. Tunnel Repainting Project Update

Mr. Stelzer reported the tunnel mural repainting project was done except for application of a graffiti prevention coating. Chair Mooney and Ms. Abslag volunteered to apply the coating on Thursday, June 20, 2019, 1 p.m.

Committee discussion covered participants, food donations, and vendor appreciation letters.

Ms. Abslag presented color photos of scenes from the new tunnel mural. RCAPP's cost for refreshments for the student painters was \$250. She has or will send thank-you letters to Denfeld Paints, McDonald's, and Jersey Boys Pizzeria.

B. Outdoor Art Gallery Cleanup Event

Chair Mooney presented two color photos of Redmond volunteers from Windermere Central Oregon Real Estate cleaning artworks in the City's outdoor public art gallery.

Ms. Abslag said she would send a thank-you letter to Windermere.

C. Art Around the Clock – Contract Revision Page 2

Ms. Abslag reported difficulty in getting artists to pick up artworks when their contracts expire.

Committee members discussed impacts of artists not picking up their artworks on time and ways to encourage them to do so.

Motion 3 (6/0/0): Ms. Burton moved to modify the Agreement for Public Exhibition of Art Around the Clock in Redmond, Oregon, to be ten (10) days following the end of the exhibit period and other alterations that Jackie Abslag deems necessary to deter tardiness of retrieval of art. Chair Mooney seconded the motion which passed unanimously.

D. Budget

Chair Mooney reported RCAPP's funding request was included in the City budget for fiscal year 2019-2020.

Committee members discussed grant possibilities and ways to improve RCAPP's success. Ms. Burton volunteered to help write grant applications.

Ms. Abslag asked RCAPP members to contact her about potential grants.

CITIZEN COMMENTS

Ms. Snider reported Dry Canyon Arts Association (DCAA) was attracting new, enthusiastic members and working on its September art show. The next DCAA Board meeting will be on Thursday, June 20, at Thelma's Place.

STAFF COMMENTS

Mr. Roberts said Ms. Abslag and Chair Mooney would meet with City Council on Tuesday, June 25, 2019, to provide an update on Art Around the Clock. He suggested showcasing Public Works' employees who help with art installations. Ms. Abslag said she would prepare a PowerPoint presentation and talking points for Chair Mooney.

Mr. Roberts said City Communications Manager Heather Cassaro was trying to get an eBlast press releases out on both the art-cleaning by Redmond realtors and the tunnel repainting. He has not seen anything in The Bulletin or The Redmond Spokesman about that. Ms. Abslag reported Geoff Folsom, senior reporter for The Redmond Spokesman, was present during the mural painting.

Committee members discussed media alternatives for RCAPP announcements, such as Cascade A&E.

COMMITTEE MEMBER COMMENTS

Chair Mooney reported Redmond ranked #10 on Oregon's "Best Cities to Live In" list for 2019, population over 25,000 (source: <https://www.chamberofcommerce.org/best-cities-to-live-in-oregon>). Bend was #11.
